

BABES WITH BULLETS | LADIES ACTION PISTOL CAMP

Skill Level: PH101/201 (Beginner) May 20-22, 2011

DATE: Arrival late afternoon/early evening on Thursday, May 19th. Range days, approximate hours of 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on Friday and Saturday, May 20th and 21st. Depart late Sunday afternoon.

PLACE: The Routt County Rifle Club in Steamboat Springs, CO.

Driving Directions: The Routt County Rifle Club is on Hwy 40 (the main street through town, also known as Lincoln) just west of Steamboat.

AIRPORT: The Hayden/Steamboat Regional Airport is serviced by United Airlines in May and is less than a thirty-minute drive from the range. It is an hour from Bear Mountain Ranch. Driving time from Denver International Airport is approximately three hours to the range (less than 2 1/2 hours to Bear Mountain Ranch). If you choose to fly into DIA and drive to Steamboat, we will try to put you in touch with other campers so that you can carpool from Denver.

LODGING: The lodge at Bear Mountain Ranch, which is approximately 30 minutes from the range. www.BearMountainRanch.com

Driving Directions: From the Hayden/Steamboat airport, turn right (east) on Hwy 40 from the airport. Travel through Steamboat. The ranch will be on your left after mile marker 160. From Denver, take I-70 through the Eisenhower Tunnel, and exit in Silverthorne onto Hwy 9. Travel 38 miles on Hwy 9, turning left onto Hwy 40 in Kremmling. The ranch will be on your right approximately 24 miles northwest of Kremmling, after mile marker 161.

EQUIPMENT: Handgun suitable for Practical Pistol competition. Holster and magazine pouches along with competition style belt. 400 to 500 rounds of ammunition.

Loaner equipment is available to those ladies that do not have the appropriate handgun, holster, or magazine pouches. Our loaner handguns are Smith & Wesson M&P 9mm pistols. We also have BladeTech holsters and magazine pouches for these pistols.

Campers will need a tactical belt, which comes in 1.25" or 1.5" width. These belts are available at many gun stores, Sportsman's Warehouse, Cabela's, and stores that sell police gear. They are also available online through suppliers like Brownell's or Dillon. Be sure to bring pants or shorts that have belt loops and make sure the loops can accommodate a wide belt.

CAMP DESCRIPTION: This camp is suitable for novice to intermediate level shooters. There will be enough instructors to divide students according to skill level if necessary. By the second day of camp the novice shooters will be able to join the more experienced shooters to work on many of the basic skills as well as being introduced to some more advanced skills. On the third day of camp all campers will participate in a Practical Pistol match.

INSTRUCTORS: Your two primary instructors will be two-time IPSC World Champion/nine-time USPSA National Open Champion, Kay Clark Miculek; and nine-time USPSA Limited Champion, Lisa Munson. Additional instructors will be added depending on the number of campers. Instructor to student ratio will be approximately 1:6.

COST: \$650 for USPSA members, \$675 for non-USPSA members. (The extra \$25 will be spent to sign campers up for a one-year USPSA membership. www.uspsa.org) Cost includes two and 1/2 days of instruction, participation in a Practical Pistol match, and group lodging.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT USING THE SHOPPING CART: If you register and pay online with your VISA, MasterCard, or Discover card full payment is required. If you prefer to pay by check or money order chose the “check or money order” payment option and mail a copy of your invoice with payment. If paying by check or money order you may choose to send in a 50% deposit to reserve a spot in camp. Full payment is due 60 days before the start of camp.

REFUND POLICY: Full refunds are available with 60 days cancellation notice. Cancellation notices received after the 60-day deadline will receive a full refund only if the vacated spot can be filled.
