

Babes with Bullets™/Ladies Action Shooting Camps
Hosted by the Wyoming Antelope Club

DATES: Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. October 20-22.

PLACE: The Wyoming Antelope Club. 3700 126th Avenue North, Pinellas Park, Florida, 34622. The phone number at the range is 727-573-3066. The club website is www.antelopeclub.org. Directions are available at the website.

INSTRUCTORS: Your two primary instructors will be two-time IPSC World Champion/nine-time USPSA National Open Champion, Kay Clark Miculek; and nine-time USPSA Limited Champion, Lisa Munson. Additional instructors will be added depending on the number of campers. Instructor to student ratio will be approximately 1:6. We anticipate that this camp will fill to the maximum of 30 students. If so, there will be five instructors.

CAMP COORDINATOR: Deb Ferns, author of Babes with Bullets™, has been coordinating these camps across the country since 2005. Please note that Deb does typically attend each novice camp with a camera crew of “Babes alumnae” who gather footage to be used at our marketing website of www.BabeswithBullets.com.

PRICE: \$650 for USPSA members, \$675 for non-USPSA members. (The extra \$25 will be used to sign you up for a one year USPSA membership.) This price includes instructor fees, range fees, lodging, lunch and dinner.

MEALS. Lunch and dinner are provided. Campers are responsible for providing their own breakfast. It is usually best to wait until you have received your condo or cabin assignments before purchasing breakfast items. This way you can make breakfast plans with your roommates so that you can split the cost of basic items like bread, milk, coffee, etc..

LODGING: We will likely be sharing condominiums. There will be at least six campers in each condo so some ladies will be sleeping on couches or air mattresses. At the very least, you will be sharing a bed. If you live close by and choose to go home each night that is fine. However, there is no discounted rate if you do not utilize the group lodging. If you have friends that you want to room with we will do our best to accommodate you.

If you prefer more private accommodations you may want to consider staying at a nearby hotel at your own cost.

AIRPORT: The closest major airport is the Tampa International Airport (TPA). If you are interested in sharing a rent car with other campers, who may also be flying to attend camp we try our best to put you in contact. We do not provide a shuttle service.

AIRLINE TRAVEL WITH FIREARM. Your firearm must be packed in a hard-sided, lockable case. The hard plastic case that many handguns come in from the factory is fine as long as it can be locked. (I usually put this small gun case in my large suitcase.) When you check in at the ticket counter tell the attendant that you are traveling with firearms and need an “Unloaded Firearms” tag. You will sign this tag and place it with your gun case. You will

then be sent to the TSA counter to have your bags inspected. **Do not leave the TSA counter until you are sure your bags have passed inspection.**

ARRIVAL TIME & PLACE: We will gather at the condo/house on Tuesday afternoon at 5:00 pm for a pre-camp briefing and to pass out loaner equipment. If you will not be arriving until later in the evening please let us know by either emailing Kay@Bang-Inc.com or Deb@BabeswithBullets.com

CAMP DESCRIPTION: This camp is suitable for novice to intermediate level shooters. There will be enough instructors to divide students according to skill level if necessary. By the second day of camp the novice shooters will be able to join the more experienced shooters to work on many of the basic skills as well as being introduced to some more advanced skills. On the third day of camp all campers will participate in a Practical Pistol match.

EQUIPMENT: Handgun suitable for Practical Pistol competition. Holster and magazine pouches along with competition style belt. 400 to 500 rounds of center-fire ammunition. (Some novice shooters may spend half of the first day shooting .22 caliber pistols and as a result need less center-fire ammunition than others.) For those shooting their own gun and possibly needing to ship their own ammo we will provide you with a local address for shipping prior to camp.

Complimentary loaner equipment is available to those ladies who do not have the appropriate handgun, holster, or magazine pouches. Our loaner handguns are Smith & Wesson M&P 9mm pistols. We also have BladeTech and Safariland holsters and magazine pouches for these pistols. Please do not run out and purchase a gun for camp; utilize a loaner instead.

Campers will need a tactical belt, which comes in 1.25" or 1.5" width. These belts are available at many gun stores, Sportsman's Warehouse, Cabela's, and stores that sell police gear. They are also available online through suppliers such as Brownell's. Make sure the belt loops in your pants can accommodate a wide belt.

If you have any doubts about the suitability of your firearm please use ours! Loaner guns and equipment cost nothing and simplify travel plans.

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT USING THE SHOPPING CART: Online registration is available at www.bang-inc.com. If you register and pay online with your VISA, MasterCard, or Discover card full payment is required. If you prefer to pay by check or money order register online but chose the "check or money order" payment option and mail a copy of your invoice with payment, due within 14 days of making the camp reservation. If paying by check or money order you can send in a \$300 deposit to reserve a spot or pay the full amount. Full payment is due 60 days before the start of camp.

REFUND POLICY: Full refunds are available with 60 days cancellation notice. Cancellation notices received after the 60 day deadline will receive a full refund only if the vacated spot can be filled.
